## CFY Applicants

Vegas Voice Institute is seeking a highly qualified graduate of an accredited Speech-Language Pathology Program to complete a 12 month CFY position plus an additional 2 year commitment thereafter or more. CFY applicants must be interested and dedicated to the evaluation and treatment of patients with voice and swallowing disorders. Vegas Voice Institute is an outpatient voice and swallowing clinic in sunny Las Vegas, Nevada. This CFY offers experience and training in:

- Flexible and rigid endoscopic laryngeal imaging
- FEES and Modified Barium Swallow Studies
- Acoustic and aerodynamic voice assessment
- Voice and swallowing evaluation and therapy
- Aphasia and Neurological Evaluations and therapy
- General Speech Therapy Services

The CFY position will allow completion of the 9 month CFY with a 3 month window to assist the candidate in completing and receiving credentialing/licensure paperwork plus a 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year of temporary full-time employment. The candidate will be considered for a permanent full-time position at the end of this 3 year commitment if available. The candidate should have attended an accredited graduate program in speech-language pathology and completed a master's program prior to beginning the position. The candidate must have solid experience in the evaluation and treatment of voice and swallowing disorders through graduate student work and those with an emphasis on voice and endoscopy will be considered first. The candidate must have a strong academic background and solid recommendations from their graduate training program and supervisors during their clinical practicum. Interested CFY candidates should send the following items with your intro letter:

1. A curriculum vitae
2. Four letters of recommendation: 2 from their graduate clinical supervisors, one from their externship supervisor, and a personal letter or recommendation from a longtime friend or family. Please have persons writing your letter to send directly to the email address below with your name in the subject line.
3. An **official** transcript from undergraduate speech pathology program either mailed to our clinic address or sent electronically via email below. Also, send an unofficial transcript one from their graduate program up to the current date.
4. Write a stroboscopy and voice evaluation report so that we may see your writing and thinking skills. The evaluation should be a full report like you would do on a patient you

were recommending voice therapy. Also, submit to us a progress report on a dysphagia patient who has done 10 treatment sessions of speech therapy.
